2017 TRANSPONDER RULES

- 1. Transponders will be used for the 2017 season and beyond at Southside Speedway. Transponders are mandatory for all divisions.
- 2. Drivers who do not have transponders may borrow one from another driver.
- 3. Mounting Instructions:
 - a. All transponders shall be mounted 72 inches, plus or minus 2 inches from the front edge of the front bumper, measured from the center of the car.
 - b. You must make sure there is a direct signal to the ground with no object between the transponder and the track surface.
 - c. You must register your number and test your transponder with track officials.
 - d. Transponder mounted in any location other than described above will be subject to disqualification.
- 4. Drivers are responsible for any transponder damage if using a track transponder.
- 5. Results may be viewed on mylaps.com.
- 6. Finishing positions as determined by the transponders may be overruled by track officials if there is a clear difference at the finish line.
